



Notice of Race

Event: Zoom 8 Eurocup 4

Date: 11 to 12 September 2010

Organizer: Halmstads Segelsällskap, www.hss1910.nu

1. Rules

1.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

1.2 This Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions and the class regulations will apply.

1.3 Swedish competitors shall when racing under Handicapping System and Rating Rules follow the licensing rules for advertising as decided by the Swedish Sailing Federation.

1.4 The Organizing Authority may require all boats to display advertising in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20. Such advertising shall be affixed in accordance with the sailing instructions and may not be changed or removed during the regatta without written approval of the Organizing Authority.

2. Eligibility requirements

2.1 The person in charge onboard the boat shall be a member of his/her Member National Authority or one of its affiliated organisations.

2.2 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance.

2.3 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

2.4 All competitors shall be no more than 19 years old in the year of the event (2010).

Each national authority is responsible to ensure that its competitors comply with this requirement.

2.5 Each team is required to bring to the venue one of their national flag in approximate size 1,0 x 1,5 m.

3. Entries

3.1 **Advance entry shall be made not later than 2010-09-03 by filling out the entry form at the following web site:**

3.2 The entry fee is 350 SEK and is paid to Bank Giro 301-4388,

Late entry will be accepted not later than 2010-09-10 to a increased entry fee at 800 SEK.



4. Registration and measurement checks

4.1 Registration and measurement shall be made at the race office between 16.00 – 20.00 on Friday the 10th or Saturday the 11th between 8.00-9.30

4.2 Measurement certificate shall be presented prior to racing.

4.3 All boats, sails, equipment and measurement certificate will be controlled within the period of "Registration and measurement".

5. Sailing Instructions

5.1 The sailing instructions will be handed out upon completion of the registration.

6. Time schedule

Prize giving ceremony will start as soon as possible after the ending of the protest time for the last race.

6.2 6 races are scheduled.

7. Race format

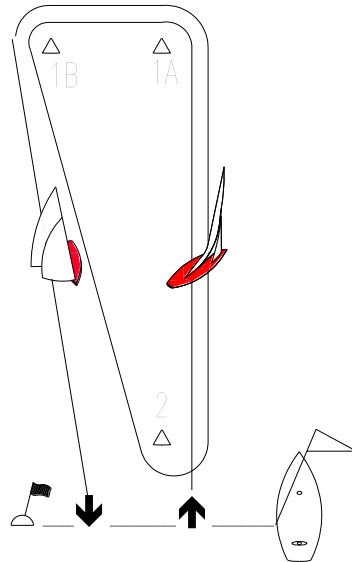
7.1 One fleet/class will be sailing, the same for girls and boys. Details will be described in the sailing instructions.

8. Racing area

8.1 The racing areas will be outside the harbor of Halmstad.

10. Protests and penalty systems

10.1 RRS Appendix P will apply.

10.2 An international jury will be appointed. The decisions of the international Jury will be final in accordance with RRS 70.5.

11. Scoring

11.1 The low point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply, modified so that when three (3) or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When from four (4) to eight (8) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. When from nine (9) to twelve (12) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

12. Prizes

12.1 Medals will be awarded to the first three. Prizes will be awarded to one third of the entered boats in each class, maximum 15 prizes.

13. Radio communication

13.1 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.



14. Team, Coach and Support boat

14.1 All coach boats, team boats and support boats must be registered at the Race Office before entering the race area, at least one hour before the first warning signal of a race.
